

**Mid Florida Buckskin Horse Association**  
**2009 Year End Circuit and Weekend Rules**

1. MFBA membership is mandatory. Youth exhibitors, amateur exhibitors and horse owners must be MFBA members.
2. Points are accrued from date MFBA membership dues are paid. To enter a class you must state that you are participating in the year end award program and show your MFBA membership card or Pay immediately for the membership. Family memberships only apply to the spouse and children under 19 years of age.
3. There must be a minimum of 10 points earned to be eligible for high point award categories.
4. Horse or horse/rider combination must show in a minimum of six shows. (Each judge counts as one show.).
5. In youth and amateur classes, points will be computed on horse and rider combination.
6. In open IBHA classes, points will be computed on the horse. If the horse should change ownership during the circuit, the points earned will go with the horse providing the new owner is a MFBA member. The horse will accrue no points after the sale date until such time the new owner purchases a MFBA membership. Open in these awards refers to the Open Division of IBHA not All Breed.
7. High Points Award Categories: Year end Grand and Reserve Awards will be given in the following categories providing the above criteria are met: Halter Stallions, Halter Geldings, Halter Mares, Dun Factor, Buckskin color horse, Youth Activities 13 and under, Youth Activities 14 -18, Amateur All Around, IBHA Open All Around, IBHA Yearling and 2 Year-old( classes that count are Halter, Dun Factor or Buckskin Color, Longe Line, In-Hand Trail and Futurity riding classes), IBHA Open Speed, and Pee Wee 12 & under Walk Trot All Around.
8. Class recognition: Recognition will be given to the first and second place contestant in each class that accumulates the most points for the year( This is in essence a Honor Roll Award). This recognition does not require the 10 point minimum (item 3) but does require the six show minimum (item 4).
9. Weekend High Point Awards: 11 High Point Categories: Halter Stallion, Halter Mare, Halter Gelding, Yearling, 2 Year Old, Dun Factor, Amateur, Youth, IBHA Open All Around, MFBA 12&under walk/trot and IBHA Open Speed.
10. Points: In computing points for weekend and all year end awards, places will count as follows;
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> place = 6 points
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 5 points
  - c. 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 4 points
  - d. 4<sup>th</sup> place = 3 points
  - e. 5<sup>th</sup> place = 2 points
  - f. 6<sup>th</sup> place = 1 points

If there are less than 6 placings in the class, the winner will receive one point for each horse in the class. Lower placings will receive one point less than the horse above it. If there is only one horse in the class, it will receive 1 point. In computing Halter points the system used to add points to the Grand or Reserve Champion, depending on the points accumulated in each age division, shall be used.
