

Futurity Information for Exhibitors:

Futurity classes (except for stallion stakes classes, see separate rules for these classes) are limited to IBHA registered horses only. Registration papers must be presented to the show secretary at the time of entry.

Owner(s) and exhibitors must be IBHA members to show in any IBHA sanctioned class(s). Membership cards must be presented to the show secretary at the time of entry. If no proof of IBHA membership is available, an IBHA membership may be purchased at the entry booth.

2011 MFBA membership is required of owners of all futurity horses.

Results from each go-round will be tabulated and posted as soon as possible.

All entries are entitled to show in each of the four go-rounds.

The final score shall be the cumulative total of the scores of the four go-rounds.

Any ties will have the monies pooled and divided equally.

Western Pleasure futurity entries may show in either bosal, snaffle or bit; one or two hands on the reins as is appropriate to the type of equipment used according to IBHA rules.

[Walk-trot futurity entries may not enter the longe line class or any canter classes.](#)

Entries in the 2 year old lunge line futurity entries may not enter the futurity riding classes (IBHA rules apply for IBHA classes.).

In all weanling events, exhibitors may write the foal's birth date on the exhibitor's back number.

All breed Jackpot classes are single judged and awarded Saturday only. Pay back will be 80% with \$100 added. Futurity payback schedule will be used. Jackpot walk-trot may not enter any canter classes.

MFBA retains the right to change the schedule of events on the program if deemed necessary.

All tab sheets must have the release line signed before the horse may enter the arena.

Negative Coggins required. IBHA papers must be shown where required.

IBHA rules will prevail.

Futurity entries may be made before the show. If you have an entry for the futurity please note that **if you wish to enter the regular IBHA class** you must make a separate entry and pay a regular entry fee in addition to the futurity class fee. Although weanlings do not earn IBHA halter points, they will earn MFBA points towards the year end circuit.

Mid-Florida Foal Incentive registration must be made prior to the show and recorded to qualify for the additional added monies in futurity classes. \$50.00 added money will be awarded to the top placing MFBA Incentive Foal in halter, longe line and riding futurity classes. Stallion Stakes futurity classes are not included in this program. Registration fees for the MFBA Incentive Fund are: \$15 weanling/\$25 yearling/\$35 for horses 2 and over.

Stallion Stakes Incentive Fund: Only foals sired by CNB Dun and JR Captain Morgan and are eligible to show in the 2011 Stallion Stakes futurity classes. *(see Stallion Stakes Guidelines for more details)*

Futurity Payback Schedule: Futurity payback will be determined by the number of horses actually entering the ring in the first go-round of each event. Twenty-five percent (25%) will be subtracted for expenses and the balance considered as 100% in the payback schedule. Futurity payback checks will be mailed approximately 10 days AFTER the shows are over to allow time for exhibitor checks to clear. Futurity monies will be paid back as follows:

Get of Sire: The following is the IBHA rule pertaining to the Get of Sire class:

Three (3) IBHA registered get of the same sire, limited to the entered horses being four (4) years old and younger shall constitute an entry. Such entry must be made by the current owner of the sire or an exhibitor producing written permission from the current owner of the sire allowing entry of specified offspring of the sire.

Produce of Dam: The following is the IBHA rule pertaining to the Produce of Dam class:

Two (2) IBHA registered produce of the same of dam, limited to the entered horses being four years (4) of age and younger shall constitute an entry. Such entry must be made by the current owner of the dam or an exhibitor producing written permission from the current owner of the dam allowing entry of the specified offspring of the dam.

General Membership Meeting: The annual MFBA general membership meeting is scheduled to be held after the Saturday show. This meeting is open to everyone – members and non-members alike. Please plan on attending as we will be covering 2012 plans and the up coming elections.

2011 Stallion Stakes Guidelines

In addition to the IBHA futurity classes and the Florida Bred Program, MFBA offers Stallion Stakes classes at the 2011 fall shows. Guidelines for the 2011 Stallions Stakes classes are as follows:

2011 MFBA membership is required of owners of all futurity horses.

Added monies in the 2011 Stallion Stakes futurity classes will be determined by the monies collected from the stallion services sold for the 2010 breeding season.

2010 breedings from the following stallions were sold: CNB Dun and JR Captain Morgan. ***Only get from those stallions, regardless of color, will be eligible to show in the 2011 Stallion Stakes classes:*** (See full page advertisements following this page.)

Proof of sire must be presented upon entering any Stallion Stakes classes!

A stallion service may be purchased for 50% of the advertised fee, plus a \$50.00 office fee, at any time up till the 9 am, Saturday morning, before the show begins.

Added monies will be determined as follows:

Total monies collected from sold stallion services

(not including \$50 office fee) = \$ paid for ea. horse in ea. S.S. class

Number of horses entered in Stallion Stakes classes

Futurity payback checks will be mailed approximately two weeks AFTER the shows are over to allow time for exhibitor checks to clear. Stallion Stakes added monies and payback monies from entries (minus office fees) will be combined and paid back as follows:

The following Stallion Stakes classes will be offered in 2011:

Owners of stallions whose donated 2010 service sold are entitled to one paid entry in either the Stallion Stakes weanling colts or weanling fillies futurity classes. Payback will be added as if full entry were paid for those foals. Foals must have proof of parentage.

Florida Bred added money *will not* be awarded in Stallion Stakes classes
